## STANDARD FEES

### Transaction fees

Credit	15p per item
Debit	15p per item
File submission fee	£2.00 per debit or credit file processed plus appropriate automated Transaction charge.

Bacs standard fees are applied quarterly in arrears following confirmation from Bacs of the volume of Transactions and files transmitted and are included as quarterly business banking charges\* under the heading Electronic Services.

## FEES – OTHER SERVICES

### Smartcard fees

Minimum 2 per User Number

New smartcards £60

Replacement smartcards £40

At three year expiry and/or replacement due to damage/loss etc.

Smartcard charges will be debited to your Bacs settlement Account

**Paperless Direct Debit set up fee** £250

Paperless Direct Debit registration fee will be debited to your Current Account once confirmation of your live status is received from Bacs.
